

## **Superstars Class by Anna Williams**

**Background Fabric:** - 1 fat quarter.

Can be plain or patterned, dark or light that reads plain or has a very small pattern.  
Should contrast well with the fabric chosen for the star.

**Star Fabric and Zig-Zag Detail:** - 1/2 metre.

Large bold and bright patterns work well or any pattern that contrasts well with the background fabric.

**Celtic Work Fabric:** - 1 fat quarter.

Should be a good contrast to the background and star fabric.  
Batiks or closely woven fabrics work well for this.

1 metre viseoflex or similar

1 metre freezer paper

24" square, light to medium weight Vilene

Baking paper (not greaseproof) available at supermarkets.

Spray starch (available at supermarkets)

1/4" Steam-a-seam, 1 box

Paper scissors, small and sharp

Fabric scissors, small and sharp

Pencil and rubber

Chalk marking pencil

Thread to match the star fabric

Invisible thread

Cutting board and ruler

Sewing machine in good working order with manual

Open toed foot or similar (number 20 for a Bernina)

Usual sewing equipment
